OVERVIEW

Safe water is essential for health, business prosperity, and community growth. As an owner / operator of a public water supply system, your job is to provide safe water to all users. Preventing contamination and planning for future system needs will help you accomplish this.

Your state environmental agency oversees construction and operation of public water systems to make sure water is safe to drink and use. However, as legal manager of the water system, it is your job to monitor drinking water quality.

The Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA) of 1974 is a federal law that sets health and safety standards for public drinking water in the United States. It was the nation's first comprehensive drinking water law. Under the law, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) sets national standards for drinking water quality. All states must meet these standards. In 1996, Congress passed the first amendments to the SDWA in 10 years. Their focus was to prevent contamination of public water supplies. They also strengthened public health protection, and allowed for increased public involvement.

An Other-Than-Municipal water system (OTM) is a water system that serves at least 25 year round residents, or serves 15 service connections used by year round residents (anything greater than 6 months is considered year round). OTMs are owned by an entity that is not a municipality. Examples of these include mobile home parks, subdivisions, apartment buildings, and condo associations.

Use of license for State requirement - \$85 per month or \$900 annual per facility.

Hourly rate for on site service work - \$65 per man hour
